Question 1. Yes, the Yukon Green Party supports a proactive approach to how and where ATV's can be used. Much of our policy calls for actions to be made to transition many of our government services away from reactive policies and onto proactive policies.

Question 2. Yes, the Yukon Green Party supports a comprehensive ATV management plan for all of Yukon, much like our stance on land use planning - comprehensive plans are necessary in order to truly consider the value of all assets and liabilities in a given area. Damaging these before we can even account for them is not good governance.

Question 3. Yes, the Yukon Green Party supports the mandatory registration of all ATV's in Yukon. This would support our current policy of encouraging the use of efficient ORV's (four stroke and electric) for use as utility aids and transportation through special licensing and lower cost registrations.

Question 4. Yes, the Yukon Green Party will enact legislation and regulations to manage ORV's in Yukon wilderness within the first 24 months of the mandate.
